Sub: Matter related to grant of conditional permission to “Ramakrishna Ayurvedic Medical College, No. 54/2, Ramagondanahalli, Bengaluru – 560064, Karnataka” with 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course and 25 seats in 05 PG courses namely (i) Dravyaguna Vigyana-05 seats, (ii) Rasa Shastra & Bhaisajya Kalpana-05 seats, (iii) Kayachikitsa-05 seats, (iv) Shalya Tantra-05 seats and (v) Panchakarma-05 seats under Section under Section 13C/13A of the IMCC Act, 1970 for the academic session 2018-19 –reg

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to refer to the Ministry's order no. 17011/79/2017-EP (IM-1) dated 09.09.2017 related to admission matter for the year 2017-18 intimating certain shortcomings for rectification for consideration of the case for the 2018-19 session.

2. The CCIM had carried out an inspection of the institution on 05.02.2018 and re-visited on 25-26.05.2018 to reassess the available facilities of teaching and practical training as well as to verify the compliance submitted by the college and forwarded its recommendations and report to the Ministry. On examining the same, it was observed that Central Research Laboratory & Animal House, Web based computerized central registration system, Functional X-ray, ECG and USG and Aadhaar based geo location enabled attendance system as per RMS, 2016 were not available. Therefore, under provisions of the first proviso to sub-section (5) of Section 13A of the IMCC Act, 1970, an opportunity of hearing was granted to the college on 24.08.2018 to present the case.

3. The observation of hearing Committee based on submission made by the college representatives during hearing and recommendations & visitation report of the CCIM have been carefully examined in terms of the “Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016, PG Regulations, 2016 provisions under the IMCC Act, 1970, relevant regulations made thereunder, and as per approved Standard Operative Procedures (SOPs) it is found that College is fulfilling notified and approved criterion for granting conditional permission for UG (BAMS) / PG Course.

4. It has, therefore, been decided by the Central Government to **grant conditional permission** to **Ramakrishna Ayurvedic Medical College, No. 54/2, Ramagondanahalli, Bengaluru -560064, Karnataka** with **60 seats in UG (BAMS) course** and **25 seats in 05 PG courses** namely (i) Dravyaguna Vigyana-05 seats, (ii) Rasa Shastra & Bhaisajya Kalpana-05 seats, (iii) Kayacikitsa-05 seats, (iv) Shalya Tantra-05 seats and (v) Panchakarma-05 seats for the academic session 2018-19 under section 13C/13A of the IMCC Act, 1970, subject to the condition that the college shall fulfill the following requirements by 31st December, 2018:

- i. Functional Aadhaar based Geo location enabled attendance system for teaching staff, non-teaching staff, and hospital staff.
- ii. Functional USG & X-ray in the hospital.

5. In addition, following requirements should be fulfilled by the college by 31st December, 2018 to get conditional permission for the session 2019-20:

- (i) All the Requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in Regulation 3 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016 by 31st December 2018 to get conditional permission or permission for a period of five years.
- (ii) All the requirements of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Minimum Standards of Education in Indian Medicine) Amendment Regulations, 2016 (for Ayurveda);
- (iii) All the requirements of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Post Graduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations, 2016 and
- (iv) All the requirements under the provisions of the IMCC Act, 1970 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled in toto.

5. The fulfillment of the conditions attached to the permission given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted to the Ministry of AYUSH endorsing a copy to the CCIM also. The CCIM will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled by means of an inspection and submit a report in this matter to the Ministry of AYUSH for considering the permission matter from the academic session 2019-20.

6. This issues with the approval of competent authority.
